Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Statement

Dear customer,

Schneider Electric is committed to providing customers with products that are fully compliant with all regulations, international protocols, and customer standards to which they are subject. This includes complying with all requirements that regulate the materials contained within our products, including the final rules recently published by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to address the following five chemicals: Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd); Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP); Phenol, Isopropylated Phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1)); 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP); and Decabromodiphenyl Ether (DecaBDE).

Schneider Electric is aware of the newly published rules and is performing our due diligence to evaluate the presence of these substances in any of our products which are not exempt from the EPA rules. Because the new EPA rules became effective without providing the regulated community with sufficient time to respond, our due diligence analysis is focused on substance and material content data from our existing systems used to prove compliance with other international substance regulations, such as the EU RoHS (EU Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS2) and EU Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863), EU REACH (EU Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006), and California Proposition 65 (Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act).

Based on those robust substance & material data management systems that utilize full and partial material declarations, our initial conclusion is that it is unlikely that products supplied by Schneider Electric contain any of the restricted substances. In addition, we are in the process of confirming this status through obtaining updated material declarations within our supply chain.
